



**PE & Sports Funding Grant**

**Proposed Spending 2015- 2016**

From September 2013 the Government provided additional funding to schools to improve the provision of physical education and sport in primary schools. The Government is not dictating how schools should spend this money however schools will be accountable for how they spend their additional funding. The proposed funding will be allocated to schools over three academic years until 2016. For the academic year 2015- 2016 the school will receive a total of £8597 sports funding.

**In the academic year 2015- 2016 the funding will be spent in the following ways:**

- Hiring specialist qualified sports coaches to teach gymnastics and games across EYFS & KS1 alongside the teachers.
- Specialist qualified sports coaches and the PE coordinator to provide guidance, support and feedback to all teachers through a well-planned CPD programme
- Ensure that continuing professional development opportunities are provided for all teachers and support staff through regular training led by coaches and the PE coordinator.
- PE coordinator to work closely alongside coaches to ensure a broad, balanced and progressive curriculum is planned and delivered across the school.
- Provide external CPD training to upskill a higher level teaching assistant to improve the delivery of physical education across the school. This will be done through the Level 5 Certificate in Primary School Physical Education Specialism qualification.
- Continue to ensure that accurate assessment of gymnastics skills is in place to ensure pupils are progressing across the British Gymnastic Association stages.

OFSTED will evaluate the impact that the sport's funding has had on pupils' lifestyles and physical well-being.
