

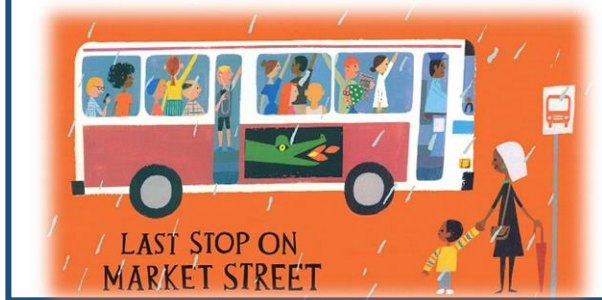
Understanding the World
