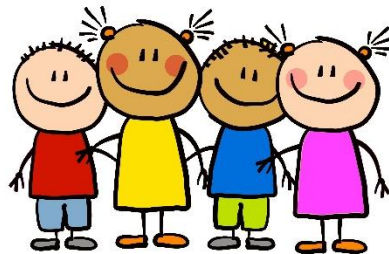


Key knowledge the children will learn:	
Understanding of the world	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will look at a wide range of different families and how everyone's family is special. We will look at each other's likes and dislikes, comparing similarities and differences through the 'Marvellous Me' box. We will look at the story of 'Creation' from the Bible and how God made us all special and unique. We will investigate the great outdoors and learn about autumn.
Expressive arts and design	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will look at colour mixing and practise making the colours we want to use for our artwork. We will draw and paint self-portraits.
Communication and language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will listen to stories, talk about what is happening and then use small world areas to retell them. We will ask each other questions during candle time and also present our special things during 'Marvellous Me'. We will learn about our three school rules and discuss and give examples of what this looks like.
Reading and writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will begin practising wordwalls and begin guided reading. We will practise daily phase 2 phonics and develop our name writing. We will listen for and practise writing initial sounds.
Physical development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will learn about a 'good space' in PE and we will explore different ways we can travel using all of our bodies. We will learn how to hold a pencil correctly.
Shape, space and measure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will draw and use 2D shapes to create pictures, such as our own faces. We will explore ways of measuring, such as cups in the water area. We will explore 3D blocks to create models and buildings.
Number	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will develop our number recognition 0-10, number ordering and we will practise touch counting. We will sing number songs and rhymes, such as 10 green bottles and also begin to explore Numicon.

What key vocabulary will be learning?	
Spelling	Definition
Unique	If something is unique, it is one of a kind. Everyone is unique because no two people are exactly the same. We all look different and like and dislike different things.
Friend	A friend is someone who you know well and like. It's someone who you can play with. You can always make new friends.
Share	It means you take it in turns so you both can have a turn.
Season	There are four seasons in a year. Each one has different types of weather. There is spring, summer, autumn and winter.
Autumn	Autumn is a season. The weather starts to get a bit colder, the leaves begin to change colour and lots of trees lose their leaves.
Deciduous	This is a kind of tree. If a tree is deciduous, it means its leaves fall off every year and it grows new ones.
