

What key knowledge will we be teaching?	
This is what we will want the children to know, understand and be able to do:	
Awareness of the past (History)	That the past is something that has already happened and can have an impact on the future.
Historical events in their locality (History)	Children to find out about Normanton's past and the events that have happened e.g. Queen Victoria visiting the train station.
Human and physical features of their surroundings. (Geography)	Children to understand the difference between human and physical features and use taught vocabulary correctly e.g. house, town.
Recognise a range of landmarks. (Geography)	Using photographs, aerial photographs and maps children will recognise and learn how to find landmarks in Normanton.
Using maps (Geography)	Children to understand how maps are used and create maps of their local/school environment.


Geography: During Autumn 1 we will be looking to our home town of Normanton. We will develop our geographical vocabulary and skills as we use maps and photographs of our environment.
