

What key knowledge will we be teaching?

This is what we will want the children to know, understand and be able to do:

Name and locate the five oceans	Children will be able to know the 5 oceans and understand where to find them on a map.
Understand geographical similarities and differences through studying the human and physical geography.	Children will develop a deeper understanding of the key human and physical features by comparing two towns - Normanton and Whitby. They will also look at the similarities and differences of each.
Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to: * key physical features, including: beach, cliff, coast, forest, , ocean, river, soil, season and weather * key human features, including: city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop	Children to use newly taught vocabulary correctly when talking about the different human and physical features of Normanton and Whitby.

Topic: Under the sea

Spelling	Definition
Oceans	An ocean is one of the five areas of sea.
Seaside	An area that is close to the sea.
Globe	A ball shaped object with a map of the world on it. The World is often referred to as the globe.
Physical features	The natural features of the earth. E.g. soil, mountains, rivers, oceans and deserts.
Human features	The man made features. E.g. homes and factories.

Key information:

Geography: Children will be developing their understanding of the 5 oceans, plotting them on a map and investigating which countries border each ocean.

Children will also be investigating the differences and similarities between Whitby (a seaside town) and Normanton (Studied in Autumn 1).
