Learning from home

During the Coronavirus pandemic there may be times where your child needs to self-isolate. During this time school will continue to provide home learning activities and support you and your child at home. Here is our Home/School Learning charter. In here it explains more about what we will offer as a school and what we expect from parents at home. We recognise that this may be a difficult time for families but please be assured we are here to support you and your child whilst they are unable to attend school.

We will:

- Provide a home learning pack for your child that will include all the resources they will need to learn from home.
- Provide your child with reading books and aim to hear your child read over the telephone during their isolation period.
- Provide some live lessons via Seesaw for your child to watch.
- Provide some direct small group teaching via zoom delivered by the teacher. We will ensure there are two members of staff on this video call for safeguarding purposes.
- Provide a food hamper for any families who are eligible and deliver this for you.
- Provide telephone contact and guidance should you need help supporting your child at home.

We ask:

- That where possible you support your child with their home learning and encourage them to 'have a go'.
- That you try and maintain contact with school by answering telephone calls made by staff, these may come up on your phone as a school mobile or unknown number.
- That when your child is working with a member of staff, for example reading, that you help facilitate this by helping your child get the resources they need ready, having your phone on speaker phone and sitting with them providing support.
- That if your child is receiving live lessons in small groups via zoom that we have your consent to teach your child using this video calling service. We will ask for an email to send you the link to the learning session.
- We ask that you support your child by providing a quiet space for them to work, set up the lesson and ensure that they are appropriately dressed and are supervised throughout the session.
- That you telephone school should you need any support and/or advice.

We hope that by working together we can ensure the very best outcomes for all of our children at this difficult time. Signed:
