The school uniform policy is as follows:

- © Yellow polo shirt
- © Royal blue sweatshirt or sweat cardigan
- © School shoes (not trainers please)
- © Navy skirt, pinafore dress, shorts or trousers
- © School shoes (not trainers or shoes with heels)

Summer wear

© Pupils can wear blue or yellow school dresses (striped or checked material) or navy shorts

PE kit

For health and safety reasons it is important that all pupils are dressed appropriately for any physical activity.

PE kit includes:

- White t-shirt
- Plain navy shorts and plain navy tracksuit bottoms and top
- Trainers or black pumps
- © <u>Indoor sessions</u> ~ Pupils take part in bare feet or in pumps. Bare feet is important especially in gymnastics when using the apparatus as it ensures a firm, controlled grip.
- © <u>Outdoor sessions</u> ~ Pupils need a pair of plain black school pumps or trainers. They will need a pair of plain black or navy tracksuit bottoms and a tracksuit top.
- © PE kit should be kept in a named drawstring bag. Please do not buy your child any other type of bag as we have limited space in our cloakrooms.
- © PE kit is best kept at school and returned home for washing at weekends or holidays.
- © Please check regularly that your child's kit still fits him/ her, especially their pumps.

Jewellery

For health and safety reasons, if pupils wish to wear ear rings, these MUST be the stud design only, no loops please. Pupils may wear a watch (not a smart watch) but rings, necklaces and bracelets must be left at home. Hair accessories such as slides, ribbons, bobbles etc should be simple and preferably in the school colours, blue or yellow.

Sun protection

Please can your child bring a sun hat to wear for protection whilst out in the playground during the summer and early autumn. They can also bring sunglasses if they wish.

Named items

The only disadvantage to wearing school uniform is the obvious one... what to do when something is lost or found! Everyone's sweatshirt looks the same! Children often feel warm when they are indoors or outside on the grass in the summer months. They take off their sweatshirts and then get mixed up which is theirs. Worse still, they leave them outside and we have a difficult time trying to match them with their owners again! We have lost property boxes in every cloakroom. By the end of each term they are usually over flowing with odd gloves, socks, hats and of course sweatshirts!

To save time, trouble, upset and money, please can you clearly name all school uniform items and check after every wash that your child's name is still clearly visible. Thank you.
