Dear Parents and Carers,

End of year reports

Today you will have received your child's end of year school report. I hope you will be pleased to read about the progress your child has made. Our Upper Foundation Stage pupils will have additional information about their Foundation Stage Profile scores, all Year 1 pupils will have information about the national phonics test and all Year 2 pupils will have details of their end of Key Stage One attainment. Information about your child's attendance has also been provided. Please note that there is also a comment slip for you to write your comment and return to school. Our teachers really appreciate and enjoy reading your comments so please take the time to do so. Thank you. Happy reading!

If you have any concerns about your child's report and wish to discuss these with your child's teacher, please call into class to make specific appointment arrangements with your child's teacher. They will be more than happy to talk to you.

Extreme heat

As you will be aware, the weather between Sunday and next Tuesday is extremely hot and the Met Office has just this morning issued a red weather warning. In line with recent Government guidance for schools we are taking the following steps to ensure that the safety and comfort of our staff and children can be met.

- ✓ Your child will need a full water bottle in school every day (which they can refill throughout the day). They will need to wear a sun hat and sun cream needs to be applied, before school. Sun cream can also be placed in your child's book bag for them to re-apply at lunchtime. Please name all bottles of sun cream. We will be encouraging children to drink plenty of cool water throughout the day. Please fill water bottles with only still plain water.
- ✓ We will ensure children get fresh air on these days; however, we will limit the amount of outdoor activity and shaded areas will be available, which will be rotated for each class. Outdoor PE will not take place. Lunchtime outdoor time will also be limited and pupils will be spending time in shaded areas. Indoor activities will also be provided. Nursery and Upper Foundation Stage pupils will have a limited amount of time in their outdoor areas.
- ✓ We will keep the use of electric light to a minimum and switch off electric equipment, such as computers, and the interactive whiteboards, when not in use.
- ✓ We will ensure that the windows are fully opened as early as possible in the morning, before the children arrive, to allow stored heat to escape the building. As the day progresses, the guidance then suggests that the windows are almost closed when the outdoor air becomes warmer than the air indoors - this should help keep the heat out while allowing adequate ventilation.
- ✓ We have taken the decision to change the date of our Year 2 concert due to the large numbers of people in the church and also the need for children to wear costumes etc. Our Year 2 show will not take place on Tuesday but will now take place on Thursday 21st July. Church doors will open at 6.15pm on Thursday for a 6.30pm start.

Year 2 show- Thursday 21st July

The children have been busy rehearsing behind the scenes for the show! They have taken on many important roles such as dancers, actors, musicians and narrators. They have also been involved in costumes and set design behind the scenes. Parents of Year 2 children are asked to bring their child back to school to their usual classroom door at 4.45pm where the staff will get them ready for the performance. The children will need to wear plain black shoes or pumps for the show. Tickets have been selling fast so thank you to families who have purchased tickets. If you have not yet purchased your two tickets please do so before Thursday. We will look forward to our Year 2 families at the show on Thursday evening. Thank you.
