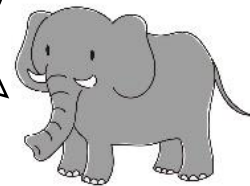


The Exceptional Elephants

8th April - School reopens

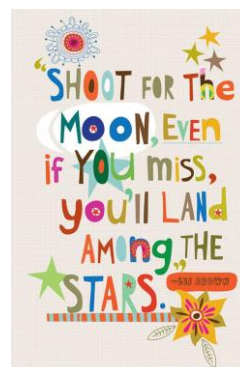
2nd May - RE trip to places of worship
