Please note that the children are due to return at the slightly later time of 3.30pm. We are looking forward to hearing all about the day and the children will be continuing to use what they have learnt as geographers on their visit.

The children will be joining Mr Price and the rest of the staff at playtime to move a mile in a variety of different ways such as hopping, skipping and jumping their way around the school field!
