Reading

You will have seen that your child has been coming home with some phonics home learning. This will continue to be sent out every Friday and is to help you to support your child at home with their phonics. Their home learning sheet includes the sounds they have been taught that week in their phonics sessions and some words containing those sounds (as well as sentences). Please support your child to practise saying the sounds they have learned and then applying them to the words using our school reading routine: **Spot it** (spot the sound eg: ay), **segment it** (sound it out, saying all of the sounds eg: t-r-ay), **read the word** (blend all of the sounds together to read the word). If you would like any further advice on how to support your child with their phonics, please come and see me and I will be happy to help you or, if you are free to attend our phonics drop ins next Monday you can see this for yourself.

Physical Education

This half term, Year 1 PE sessions will usually take place on a Thursday and Friday. Children will need their PE kit in school on these days but it is best to leave this in school all week in case of last minute changes. Please ensure all items are labelled with your child's name so that any lost items can be easily returned. Whilst the weather is still fine, we may go outside for some of our sessions. Therefore, we are happy for children to have a pair of black jogging bottoms and a hooded top to keep them warm.

Forgiveness

Our Christian value for this term is 'Forgiveness'. We will be thinking about what it means to forgive and the importance of forgiveness. Using key stories from the Bible, such as 'Jacob and his Twelve Sons' we will consider what these stories tell us about forgiveness and what they teach us about God.
